Course Description: A 6-week landscape watercolor class. Participants develop painting skills, techniques, and aesthetic sensibilities to artistic expression in the watercolor medium. - 1 pad of cold press watercolor paper (size 11x17)
- 1 Drawing board (11x17)
- Graphite Pencil
- Kneaded rubber eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- Plastic palette
- Tackle box
- Stadium Chair or stool

### Watercolor supplies:

**Brushes:** (synthetic bristles)

Flat 3/4", 1/4", #6, #2, Round #4, #2, 0.2

Flat Wash Brush 1 inch (you can purchase the at your local hardware store)

### Paint, 15 ml tubes (Note you can also purchase a watercolor kit)

Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Red, Aureolin Yellow, Cadium Yellow, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine Blue, Viridian (Green)
